Host was transformed into Flesh

In 1263 a German priest, Peter of Prague, stopped at Bolsena while on a pilgrimage to Rome. He was celebrating Mass in the Basilica of Bolsena, and when the moment of consecration arrived, the Host was transformed into Flesh. This miracle strengthened the wavering belief of the priest in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharistic. The Sacred Body was inspected by Urban Pope IV and by St. Thomas Aquinas. This miracle helped convince the Pope to extend the feast of Corpus Christi to the universal Church so that everyone could recognize the love God has for those who love and worship him.

Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena

Italy, 1264

The Eucharistic miracle of Bolsena, depicted by Raphael in a well-known fresco in the Vatican Palace, took place in 1263. A German priest, Peter of Prague, stopped at Bolsena while on a pilgrimage to Rome. He was pious, but he found it difficult to accept that Christ was actually present in the consecrated Host. While celebrating Holy Mass above the tomb of St. Christina (located in the church named for the martyr), he spoke the words of consecration and immediately Blood started to seep from the consecrated Host and trickle over his hands and onto the altar. At first the priest tried to hide the Blood, but eventually he interrupted the Mass and asked to be taken to the neighboring city of Orvieto, where Pope Urban IV resided.

The Pope send emissaries to investigate. When the facts were ascertained, he ordered the bishop of the diocese to bring the Host and the linen bearing the stains of Blood to him. He had the relics placed in the cathedral. The linen bearing the spots of Blood is still reverently enshrined and exhibited in the Cathedral of Orvieto.

Pope Urban IV was prompted by this miracle to commission St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the Office for the Mass and Liturgy of the Hours to celebrate the Most Holy Body of the Lord (Corpus Christi). One year after the miracle, in August of 1264, Pope Urban IV introduced the Aquinas's composition, and by means of a papal bull instituted the feast of Corpus Christi.

What is the Feast of Corpus Christi?

This liturgical feast falls on Sunday, June 02, 2024 in the USA and Canada. This Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ celebrates the source and summit of our Catholic faith, Jesus Christ, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament.

A Norbertine canoness, St. Juliana of Liege, from Belgium, lived with a group of women dedicated to the Eucharist. From 1208 to 1228, Christ appeared to her and told her to request the institution of the feast of Corpus Christi, and she eventually told her confessor of these visions, who then told their bishop. In 1246, her bishop ordered the first celebration of Corpus Christi in his diocese.

The feast was proposed to the universal Church by St. Thomas Aquinas and was established by Pope Urban IV in 1264 through the papal bull *Transiturus de hoc mundo*. This feast is observed in some places on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, which falls 60 days after Easter. However, in other places, it is celebrated on the following Sunday.

Corpus Christi celebrations often include a solemn procession in which the Blessed Sacrament is carried through the streets of the community or in the church or on parish property, accompanied by hymns and concluded by Benediction. Elaborate and beautiful flower wreaths and displays often accompany the procession. Those who participate in a Corpus Christi procession may obtain a Plenary Indulgence under the usual conditions.

Join the Corpus Christi Procession on June 2!



The Corpus Christi procession is a centuries-old tradition of the Catholic faith to process the Eucharist in public. Everyone is invited to declare what Catholics all over the world believe: **"Under the consecrated species of bread and wine Christ himself, living and glorious, is present in a true, real, and substantial manner: His Body and His Blood, with His soul and His divinity" (CCC 1413).**

▶ The procession has two stages, and it begins after the 8:30AM Mass; further details on how and where you can participate are on rccv.org.

ORDINARY TIME

In his Apostolic Letter approving the Roman Calendar (14 February 1969), Pope Paul VI noted some important facts about the Liturgical Year:

- Over many centuries, Catholics had become accustomed to so many special religious devotions that the mysteries of redemption lost their proper place. This was due to the large number of vigils, holydays and octaves, and to the growing dominance of various seasons over the Church year;
- St. Pius X and St. John XXIII restored Sunday to its former dignity, so that everyone should once more consider it as the Church's original Feast Day;
- The Popes restated the traditional teaching of the Church: The celebration of the Liturgical Year has a special sacramental power and force which nourishes and strengthens the life of Christians. The Church year is not merely a recalling of the historical events by which Christ won our salvation;
- The reason for the restoration of the Liturgical Year is to help believers through their faith, hope and love to share more fully in the entire mystery of Christ as it is unfolding throughout the year.
